The Newfoundland and Labrador English School Board is undertaking a review of the Marystown Central High school system for potential catchment area adjustments, grade reconfigurations, and/or closures. The review has been initiated due to a general decline in enrolment among schools within the system, and in an effort to ensure the best delivery of programs and services for all area students.

The District has compiled an information booklet, which contains details about the schools within this system. Community members are encouraged to review the booklet and provide feedback to the District via ThoughtExchange, an online consultation tool. ThoughtExchange will allow for an inclusive opportunity for all school community members to participate anonymously in the decision-making process and have their thoughts and ideas considered by their peers.
