Dear Parents and Guardians:

As you are aware, an extension has been announced for Mobile Central High School. As a result of this impending extension and recognizing enrollment pressures on St. Bernard's Elementary, the Newfoundland and Labrador English School Board is undertaking a review of the Mobile Central High System. The process includes consultation with school councils, administrators and the school communities.

The District has compiled an information booklet which contains details of the proposed grade level reconfiguration scenarios and information about the impacted schools. The proposal put forth for feedback of the school communities involves St. Bernard's Elementary becoming a Grades Kindergarten to 5 school and Mobile Central High School becoming a Grades 6-12 school. Members of the school community are encouraged to review the information booklet and then provide feedback to the District. This information is available here:

This session will be held in the gymnasium of Mobile Central High School and begin at 7:00 p.m. Members of the school community who would like to receive the information package as a presentation by District staff are invited to attend this session.
