



## Mobile Central High School System Review Feedback Summary

March 27, 2017

372 Online Feedback Submissions

- 37 duplicate entries
- 2 Blank entries
- 7 people submitted twice but different or continued comments; these comments are combined into a single entry in analysis
- 1 request to be removed from school emails

This leaves 325 unique respondents.

45 Respondents identified as Mobile Central High School

201 Respondents identified as St. Bernard's Elementary

59 Respondents identified as both schools

20 Respondents did not select a school

2 - Favour Grade 6 students attending Mobile Central High School (0.6%)

323 - Opposed to Grade 6 students attending Mobile Central High School (99.4%)

Below is a summary of the predominant issues received through online feedback:

- Build the new middle school as planned
- An extension is a 'bandaid' solution for the short term
- Rapidly growing communities need proper school infrastructure / fastest growing area in the province
- St. Bernard's Elementary does not have enough space, students eat in class, work in the halls, and there are not enough washrooms
- Will not accept an extension
- With an extension overcrowding will remain at St. Bernard's Elementary
- Grade 6 students should not be with Grade 12 students
- If extension continues, work will occur during school year and impact student's academics and safety
- Concerns expressed regarding a lack of common area space at Mobile Central High School that is not being addressed even though enrolment numbers are projected to continue to increase
- Concerns expressed regarding the size of the current science lab being inadequate for larger high school classes that are likely with increasing enrolment
